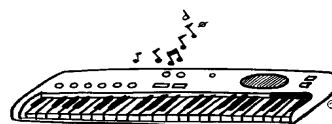
Fasting is a form of penance. By fasting, we are reminded of our neediness and our hunger for God. We pray for God's mercy, for His Love and for His guidance.
