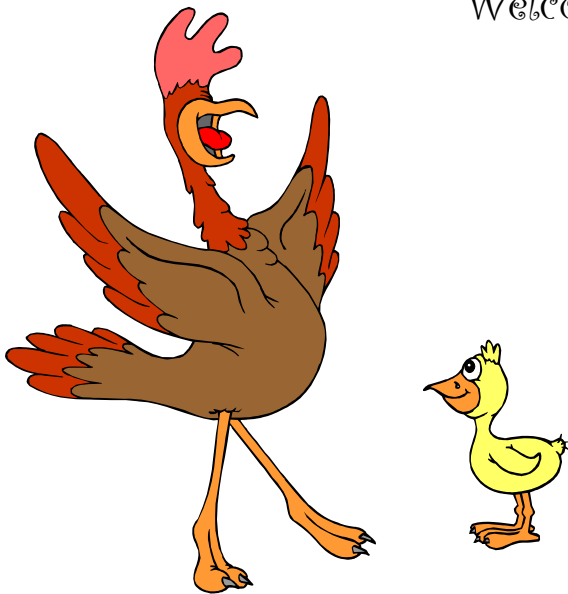

As Paul says in 2 Cor 9:7-8, "The more you sow, the more you reap...God loves a cheerful giver."

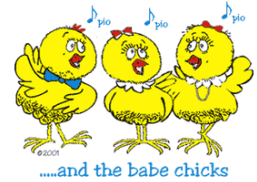
