## Music Ministry

In the parable of the talents Matt. 25: 14-30, Jesus notes that the person with five talents and the person with two talents receive the exact same praise and reward. He wanted us to know that God judges us on our own individual merits and not in reference to anyone else's merits. When I first started playing the guitar, there were many times when I felt intimidated by better guitarists. I still battle with intimidation from time to time. I think that it is a natural tendency to compare our talent with someone else's talents. Another human tendency is to look down on those who are less talented. I see that in sports coaching my kids and listening to kids on a team compare their talents with someone else. I see that at work when someone gossips to put down other people to make themselves look better. Both attitudes are wrong. It is we who make comparisons, not God.

Throughout the gospel, Jesus reminds us that true humility is what he wants from us. He wants us to recognize who we are and what we are with our talents and limitations. Jesus wants us to be glad for what we are, and not focus on what we are not. And whatever we have, it is important to Him that we give our talents away. Our talents are given to us not fully developed, but as little seeds. It is when we work with our talents and give them away that they mature and grow.

I remember back when I first started playing the guitar. My wife and I just moved to a new parish, so I went over to talk with the priest to tell him about my talents and to find out how I could contribute to the music ministry. The priest said to me, "Do you play the guitar or do you just strum." And I said, "Um, well I guess I just strum." I was so defeated that I was never going to offer to play again in church. It wasn't until I joined The Church of the Resurrection when a lady who knew about me playing the guitar in Cum Christo approached me and convinced me to play in the choir. What I have learned from my experience of playing is that you don't have to be a star to play for Jesus. He'll take whatever you have and bless it. Jesus has blessed me more than I could ever count through my music. It's Satan who wants to tell us that we are not good enough and that we don't have what it takes. God sees our capabilities far more than we see of ourselves. It's our self-talk that prevents us from fully accomplishing what He has in store for us.

The music ministry in Cum Christo wants your talent. Don't think you're not good enough. Even if you have the smallest amount of talent, won't you consider giving it away and see if God will allow that talent to grow? One of my favorite hymns is "All are Welcome." I like that song because it is what Cum Christo is all about. Especially verse five, "Let us build a house where all are named, their songs and visions heard and loved and treasured, taught and claimed as words within the Word. Built of tears and cries and laughter, prayer of faith and songs of grace, let this house proclaim from floor to rafter: All are welcome, All are welcome, All are welcome in this place."

## Guidelines for the Eligibility of a Candidate

1. Be an adult, age 21 or older. Young adults between the ages of 18 and 21 may be candidates if age-appropriate fourth day movements are not otherwise available to them in the Columbus Diocese.

2. Be baptized Christians, attending a church or desiring to grow as a Christian.

3. Be affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church, Orthodox Church, or a universally recognized mainline Protestant denomination which professes belief in and acceptance of the basic tenets of the Nicene Creed, the Bible as the inspired Word of God and the fullness of the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

4. Be ready, in the judgment of the sponsor, to have the Cum Christo experience.

5. Be in such physical, mental and emotional health as to permit the person to participate fully and constructively in the weekend.

6. Reside within the geographic confines of the Diocese of Columbus (except under special circumstances as approved by the Lay Director.)

7. Cum Christo encourages both spouses in a marriage to attend a Cum Christo Weekend.

**Ideal Way** - A Cursillista would approach a married person to arrange a meeting with both spouses. Both spouses would thereby have the opportunity to learn about Cum Christo firsthand and in each other's company. During this meeting the spouses would be invited to pray to discern whether God is leading them to attend a Cum Christo Weekend. The sponsor would encourage the spouses to communicate with each other about this opportunity to attend a weekend and then give their decisions to the Cursillista who has offered to be their sponsor. Neither spouse might attend. Both might commit to attend. Or one spouse might decide to attend soon and the other spouse might not make a commitment about Cum Christo.

**Alternative Way** - A Cursillista may have a close relationship with one spouse in a marriage but not the other. And sometimes it is difficult or impractical to follow the "ideal way." It is also acceptable for a Cursillista to meet personally with the spouse that he/she knows well, educate them about Cum Christo and invite him/her to share all information about Cum Christo with his/her spouse and to collaboratively reach a decision about having the "prospective candidate" attend a Cum Christo Weekend.

8. An application coordinator will have responsibility for reviewing all applications to insure adherence to the above eligibility requirements before processing.
