Nor should a candidate attend Ultreya on a lengthy, on-going basis before making the Weekend, but attending 6 or 7 Ultreya's as a candidate may be very beneficial. (Continued next page)

While on the subject of sponsorship –In our enthusiasm to tell others about the wonderful gift of Cum Christo, many of us tell a potential candidate that “It’s a great weekend!” or “You’ll have a wonderful time!” or “You’ll have the mountaintop experience of your life!” Telling someone that it will change his or her life may actually scare some people (of course, others may find comfort in that!) While these statements might be true for some of us, it is not everyone’s experience. When we talk to potential candidates about Cum Christo, let us not talk about how we *now* feel about the Cum Christo Weekend -- looking back to the Sunday of our weekend, but let’s try to put ourselves back in the place where we were *before* we made our weekend and to remember the anxiety, the doubt, the unfamiliarity, the insecurity of being out of touch with the outside world for 3 ½ days. We can tell them that it’s a great weekend, but also advise them that the weekend moves along slowly and not to judge the Weekend until it’s over. Some Cursillistas don’t pull it all together until well after the Weekend.

We can encourage the candidates to make a Weekend by telling them that CumChristo is a 3-day “Workshop in Christian Living” designed to enhance their spirituality, to deepen their relationship with Christ and enable them to become the leaven for apostolic action. Tell them that the Weekend provides tools that can help Christians become the people that God is calling them to be both in their personal lives and in their environments, and provides a means for similarly committed Christians to support one another in achieving this goal. The Gift of Sponsorship

When we were called to our Cum Christo weekend, God did so through another Cursillista who had previously made a weekend. We accepted this calling or gift just as we accept His ever-flowing grace. This gift of the weekend, the method and this great movement of people has been with us ever since. Many of us have accepted this gift and used it for the Glory of God. Others have felt a responsibility to share this gift with others. When we share this gift with others, we do so in a very structured way through a process of candidate sponsorship.

Sponsoring candidates for Cum Christo is made up of three very important elements. They can be defined as Pre-Cum Christo, the Weekend and Post-Cum Christo.

Pre-Cum Christo includes the selection of an appropriate candidate, explaining the weekend, grouping and Ultreya to the candidate, cleaning the center and delivering your candidate to the center on Thursday evening. Appropriate candidates are defined by the eligibility guidelines outlined in the Cum Christo Sponsorship brochure. All of this is preceded by a growing, Christ-centered relationship and prayer for this potential Cursillista.

The Weekend activities are centered on providing support for the candidate and their family during the weekend. This includes Palanca (prayer and sacrifice) for the benefit of your candidate. It also includes a visit to Serenade the candidates, and attending the closing.

Post-Cum Christo sponsorship responsibilities are of utmost importance. Beginning with a ride home from the closing, they include cleaning the center for the second Monday in a row, attending the first three Ultreyas after the weekend, helping your candidate find a group and providing support for their first year as a babe chick. Your relationship, in Christ, can grow immensely now that you share a common method and understanding of your Christian faith.

So, have you freely accepted this gift of the weekend, the method and the movement? Do you feel a sense of responsibility to share this gift with other Christian leaders? If so, continue to pray that God will reveal those who are ready for Cum Christo. And when you are called, respond with a gift of your own by accepting the responsibilities of sponsorship.
