*Find the Pattern in this Piece***

How often do we really experience silence? Even when physically silent in a quiet place, minds race, flooded with thoughts. Yet, silence helps you to know yourself. By looking inward, you recognize the prodigal person within, returning to God.

As we either seek, or avoid, the many glances that Christ offers us each day, we live out the ideal within us, for better or worse. Yet only by grace can we make Him the ideal, living out our roles as effective lay people. Only by grace can we find the motivation within ourselves to be at peace and pray, living out our commitments to piety.

Pondering the example of the figure of Christ, we are hungry to study God's world around us. Experiencing the Sacraments compels us to action. Overcoming the obstacles to grace before us transforms us into Christian leaders.

Hearing Christ's message for us in our daily environments we become motivated to live out our life in grace. We live our lives in community. We serve as leaders through action. Comforted by the total security available to us from our friends in Christ we follow this method in our Fourth Day.

This is my final column as Lay Director of Cum Christo. Next month, a fresh new lay Director will be addressing you in this space, Sally Zuccaro W58. The advice I passed on to her is the same I wrote about here: stick to the Cum Christo fundamentals.

"Know Yourself," "Prodigal Son," "The Three Glances of Christ;" "Ideal (note there is no 's' in ideal)," "Grace I,"

"Laity," "Grace II," "Piety;"

"The Figure of Christ," "Study," "Sacraments,"

"Action," "Obstacles to Grace," "Leaders;" "Study of the Environment," "Life in Grace," "Christian Community in Action," "Total Security," and "Fourth Day" represent the progression of meditations and talks on the weekend. Together they lead up to the simple message of group reunion: both weekly permanent group in your environment and frequent flying group at Ultreya. Group being a simple extension of the table discussions that are core to the weekend experience.

Grouping is the simple prescription offered by Cum Christo for living out our Baptismal promise. Group! Just do it!! De Colores!!!

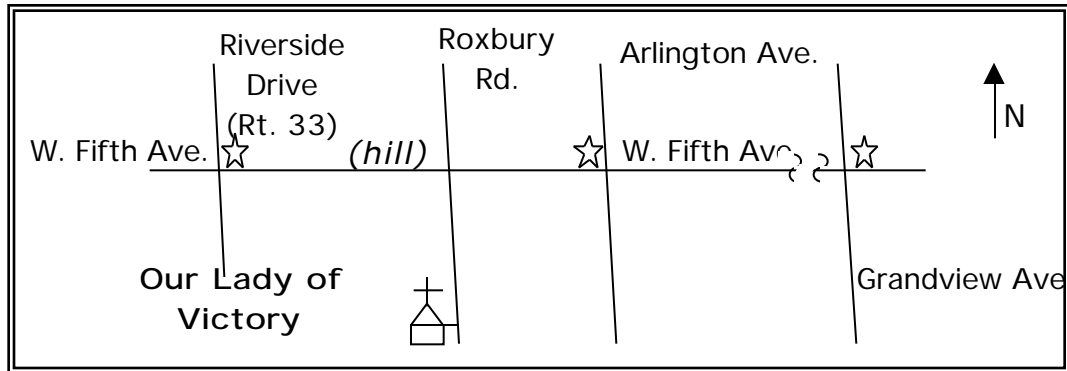

PALANCA: The essence of Palanca is sacrifice. Write extra Palanca notes addressed "Dear Babe Chick" for candidates you do not know. Palanca from strangers is powerful stuff. GENERAL Palanca is introduced on Friday afternoon; deliver it as early as possible Friday morning. PERSONAL Palanca from sponsors, spouse/family, and guardian angels is introduced on Saturday afternoon; deliver it by mid-morning Saturday and write your relationship to the candidate on the envelope. Palanca from the community is distributed Saturday evening; deliver it no later than mid-day Saturday. Palanca in the form of gifts is distributed late Sunday afternoon before the Closing.

Weekend Reminders... Be respectful of the weekend by not ringing the doorbell outside of the hours of 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Palanca can be deposited in the mail slot provided in the left entrance door.
