## From the Lay Directors

We just came off the fantastic Men's 150th Weekend – WOW! 150 Weekends! At the time of this writing, the Women's Weekend is already full. We are excited!

As we know, Palanca is the leaven of the Weekend. On Friday, Palanca is first introduced in the form of general Palanca by the Spiritual Director during the Grace talk. Then on Saturday, the candidates receive 3 pieces of Personal Palanca for the first time during their Chapel visits. These pieces should be from their sponsor, their Guardian Angel, and from their spouse, a close friend or any other. We were surprised to learn that close to 30% of the candidates do not receive this powerful written and sacrificial form of Palanca from their sponsor or Guardian Angel for their Chapel visit. What seems to be happening is that the sponsor or Guardian Angel did write their letter, but did not address the front of the envelope correctly, so there was no way for the Weekend Servant to determine from all of the Palanca received, which was from the sponsor and/or Guardian Angel.

If you attend Ultreya on Guardian Angel night (the Wednesday before the Weekend begins), you will have an opportunity to draw a name of a candidate or team member and become their Guardian Angel for the Weekend. When doing so you take on an important commitment which includes:

- ♦ Sacrificial prayer
- ♦ Writing a Palanca letter
- ♦ Labeling the envelope "Guardian Angel" in the lower left corner
- ♦ Getting the Palanca to the Center by 10:00 A.M. Saturday morning

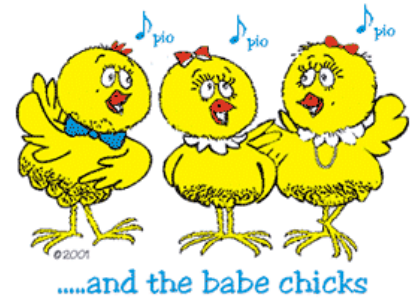
Palanca paper and note cards are made available at Ultreya so you can write your note before you leave that night and leave it at the Center.

If you are a sponsor, or a spouse who has already made the Weekend, you too, have the same commitment for doing and writing your Palanca, labeling it correctly, and getting it to the Center on time

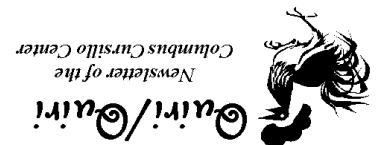
